

Nominations After Jan. 6, 2019

Nominations for diocesan leadership positions which have been received by the deadline of January 6, 2019, will be included in the 2019 Diocesan Convention packet and posted on the convention website. But it's not too late to be nominated!

After Jan. 6, nominations may be made from the floor at the convention. Nominees are responsible for bringing 300 copies of their nominee information to be handed out at the convention. **Please give the material to the Rev. Michelle Bolt before the start of convention business on Friday, February 8.**

Nominee information should be on **one sheet of paper** and include these five items:

1. Your **name, parish and parish city**
2. The **position for which you are being nominated**

3. Your **biography of 100 words or less** that describes the skills, experience and commitment you would bring to the position – please focus on church-related activities or any experience related to the position sought. ***Please do not provide more than 100 words – all other nominees were required to abide by this guide, and more text could make you less appealing to those voting!***
4. A recent **photo** (head and shoulders) included on the sheet provided to delegates.
5. A statement that you are a **confirmed communicant in good standing** in your parish.
